## GRAD HOUSE

The Grad House, originally a farm house, offers a variety of activities that cater to graduate students and the university community. In 1957, it was the only building located on the land our founders purchased to build the university.

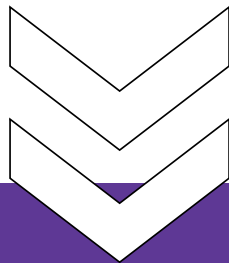
## DAVIS CENTRE

The William G. Davis Computer Research Centre (DC), the red pipe and glass building, was designed for Computer Science to look like a microchip. It houses the engineering, math, and science library, one of 8 libraries on campus. The construction, just beside the DC, is for a new Faculty of Mathematics building. It will contain a classroom that is a replica of the Toronto Stock Exchange.



## COUTTS HALL

Coutts Engineering Lecture Hall (RCH) is one of the Faculty of Engineering's 6 buildings. RCH is made up of the largest collection of lecture halls on campus. Students from all faculties, not just Engineering, take classes here.



## QUANTUM NANO CENTRE

The Mike and Ophelia Lazaridis Quantum-Nano Centre, currently under construction, will house state-of-the-art science labs that will expand the research our students and professors are conducting at the atomic and molecular level.



## LYLE HALLMAN INSTITUTE

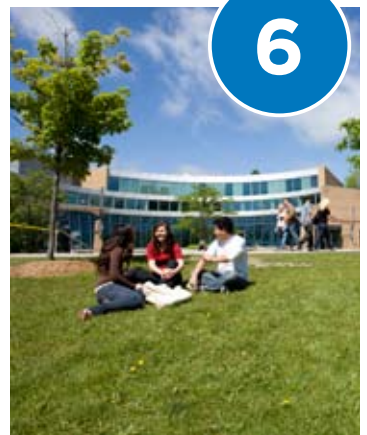
Inside the Lyle Hallman Institute for Health Promotion, one of the Faculty of Applied Health Sciences' buildings, you'll find lots of hands-on research labs that focus on transforming people's health.

## STUDENT LIFE CENTRE

The Student Life Centre, or the "living room" of the campus, is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

A great resource located inside is the Turnkey Desk. It sells bus tickets and snacks, loans out board games, and its staff can answer any question you may have.

What's inside: dental office, hair salon, full-service bank, bike shop, pharmacy, sports medicine clinic, used bookstore, computer store, offices for some of our over 160 student clubs, Waterloo Residences and Off-campus Housing offices, the Federation of Students office (similar to students' council), Watcard Office (student ID card), one of 17 eateries, and our most popular Tim Hortons location.

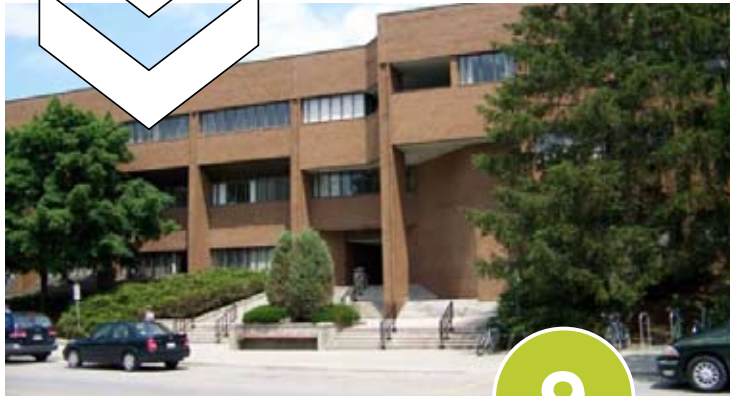
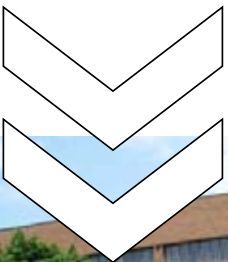
## PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES COMPLEX

If you're considering an exchange or would like to add an international opportunity to your degree, you'll want to visit Waterloo International, located inside.

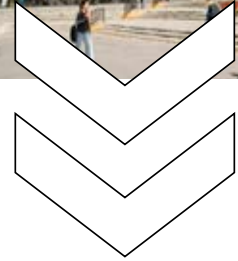
## ARTS QUAD

Waterloo founded co-operative education in Canada and today, we offer the world's largest co-op program.

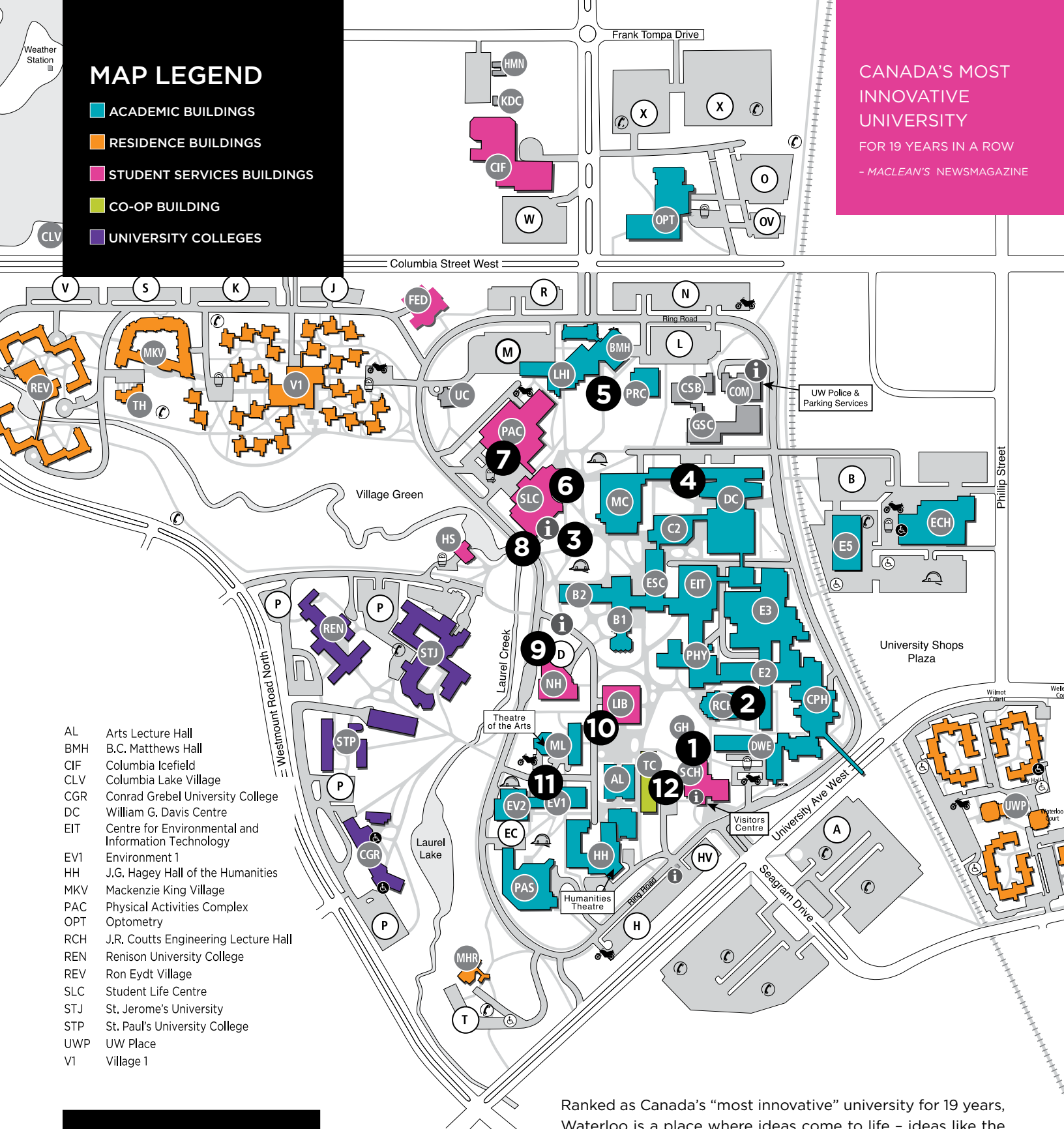
